Recent Council Actions

At its June 20, 2011 meeting, the City Council received the 2010 Comprehensive Annual Financial Report; and the legal compliance audit and management

report from the City's auditor, Malloy, Montague, Karnowski, Radosevich & Co. (MMKR). The audit report did not find any instances of non-compliance after reviewing the seven key financial areas including contracting and bidding, claims and disbursements, deposits and investments, and conflicts of interest.

The Council awarded the bid for seal coating of approximately 10 miles of City streets to Pearson Brothers in an amount of \$229,116.91. Seal coating, which involves placing a thin layer of rock to the surface of streets, is an important element in the City's overall street maintenance program. Streets in Shoreview are generally seal coated every eight years. This year's project will seal coat streets located south of Turtle Lake to Highway 96 and some streets south of Highway 96 and east of Hodgson Road.

The Council also awarded bids for seal coating of about 5 miles of trail throughout the City and for replacement of the filtration and circulation system for the hot tub in the Community Center.

Shoreview's Farmers Market

City Water Restrictions May 15 - September 15



Summer water use restrictions will again be in effect from May 15 - September 15. Residents with even numbered houses (last digit of house address) can water lawns on even number calendar days, odd numbered houses on odd number calendar days.

These restrictions do not apply to properties that use a private well for watering purposes, or for water uses including car washing, filling of children's swimming pools, children playing in a hose operated sprinkler or water toy, or hand-held watering of

plants and shrubs.

Residents with newly sodded or seeded yards may obtain an exemption from the odd-even restriction for a period of two weeks. Residents requiring an exemption should contact the Shoreview Public Works Department at 651.490.4650.
