

Lake Johanna Fire Department 2023 Annual Fire Report

In 2023 the Lake Johanna Fire Department responded to 4,618 calls for service which is an increase of 327 calls, 7.6%, from the previous year. We assisted neighboring Fire Departments a total of 66 times. We received aid 41 times in 2023.

CLOSEST UNIT DISPATCHING

All the Fire Departments in Ramsey County participate in Closest Unit Dispatching is used for specific Emergency Calls such as, Structure Fires, Cardiac Arrest calls and Water Emergencies. When one of those call types occurs, the Computer Aided Dispatch will instantly determine if there is a response unit from another agency that is closer to the incident than the host units dispatched, if so, that closest unit is added to the assigned response.


In 2023, there was 59 Closest Unit Dispatches County wide, Lake Johanna responded to five incidents (three Cardiac Arrests, one Accident Delta call and one Smoke in a Commercial Building). We received aid on four incidents (two Cardiac Arrests, one Smoke in a Dwelling and one Suicide in Progress).

The City of Shoreview had a lower dollar loss of \$1,036,330 in 2023 from the previous year. The City of Arden Hills dollar loss was \$1,592,700, an increase in the dollar loss from the previous year. The City of North Oaks had no dollar loss in 2023.

ANNUAL DOLLAR LOSS COMPARISON




Over the last 5 years the cities combined average dollar loss from Fire was \$1,712,547.


In 2023, Building fires attributed for most of the dollar loss totaling about \$1,545,000. The next highest loss total was from Vehicle fires which totaled \$60,950.

THE DEPARTMENT RESPONSE

On Duty Shift crews handled 98.6% of the calls responding to 4,557 calls in 2023. Stations were called back to assist the Shift Crews 61 times throughout the year which is roughly 1.32% of the calls.




3-year Comparison Response Time in Minutes






CALLS BY MONTH

CALLS BY DAY OF WEEK





FIRE DOLLAR LOSS BY MONTH


